

# Cheers! To 25 Years

6" finished block

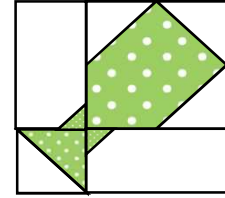
We thought it would be fun this year to make the Goblet Block to toast the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. For every block that you make your name will be put into a drawing for the blocks. They are fast and easy to do so we would suggest everyone make at least 4 but you are welcome to make lots more if you like. Depending on how many blocks there are, we may be able to draw for more than one set of blocks.

Goblet Fabric – a polka dot or swirl for the bubbly!

Cut 1 – 4 ½" square, 1 – 2 ⅞" square and 2 – 1" squares

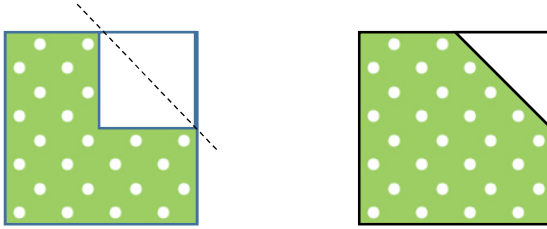
Background Fabric – tone on tone white or a small print on a white background.

Cut 3 – 2 ½" squares, 2 – 2 ½" X 4 ½" rectangle and 1 – 2 ⅞" square

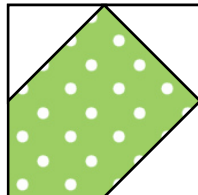


Draw a diagonal line across the 2 - 1" goblet squares, the 2 ⅞ background square and the 3 – 2 ½" background squares

1. Place a 2 ½" background square in the corner of the 4 ½" goblet square. Sew across the diagonal, trim and press toward the background.



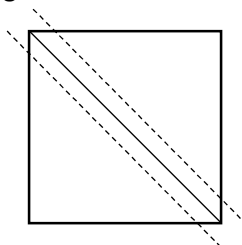
2. Repeat step one on two more sides of the goblet square



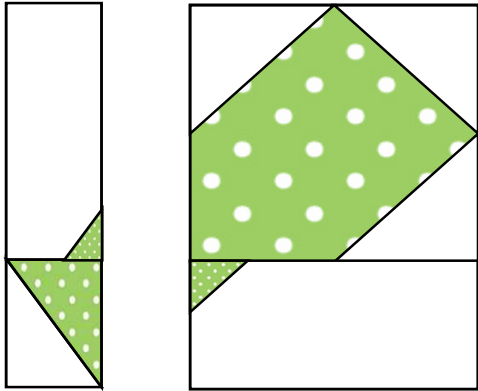
3. Place the 1" Goblet squares on one corner of each of the two 2 ½" X 4 ½" background rectangle as illustrated below. Press away from the triangle.



4. Place the 2 ⅞" squares together and sew on each side of the line. Cut on the drawn line. You will have an extra half square triangle.



5. Sew together the block as illustrated below and press toward the rectangle.



6. Sew the above units together, butting the seams. Press open.
